Council I

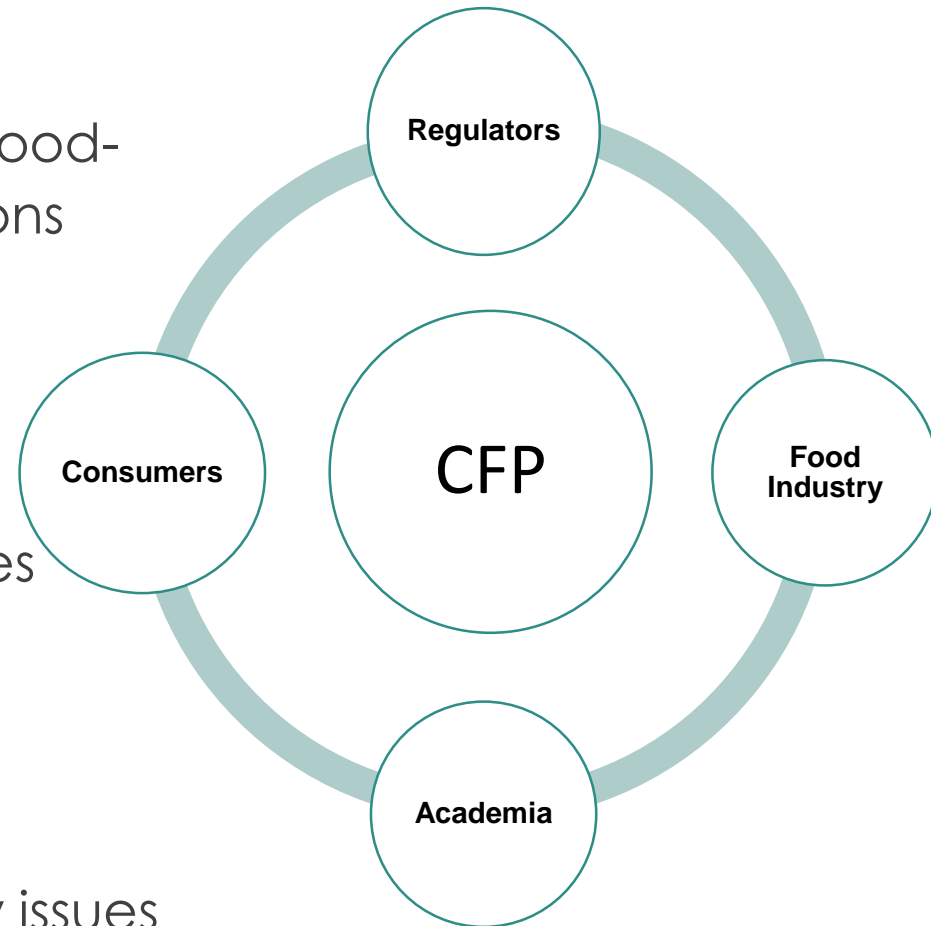
- Discusses issues involving food-related laws and regulations

Council II

- Works to develop administrative, education and certification guidelines and procedures

- Discusses the science and technology of food safety issues

2018 Significant Issues

- I-012 Harmonize labeling for mechanically tenderized beef
 - Accepted as Amended
 - Requested FDA and USDA/FSIS work to change Food Code Language to reflect new labeling requirements



2018 Significant Issues

- I-016 Resolve conflict in 3-502.12: ROP criteria
 - Accepted as Submitted
 - Rejected by state delegates because the fix would have created code conflicts

- I-027 Obtaining purchase info during outbreak investigations
 - No Action
 - Delegates rejected the “No Action”



2018 Significant Issues

- I-029 Adding chicken liver guidance into annex
 - Accepted as Amended
 - Accepted by state delegates



- I-034 Remove Pf from handwashing water temperature
 - Accepted as Amended: “A HANDWASHING SINK shall be equipped to provide hot and cold running water”
 - Rejected by state delegates

2018 Significant Issues

- III-023 Create committee regarding safe handling and cooking of roaster pigs
 - No Action
 - Delegates rejected the “No Action”
- I-022 Separation of raw animal foods by cook temperature
 - No Action – issue adequately covered in 3-302.11
 - Accepted by state delegates



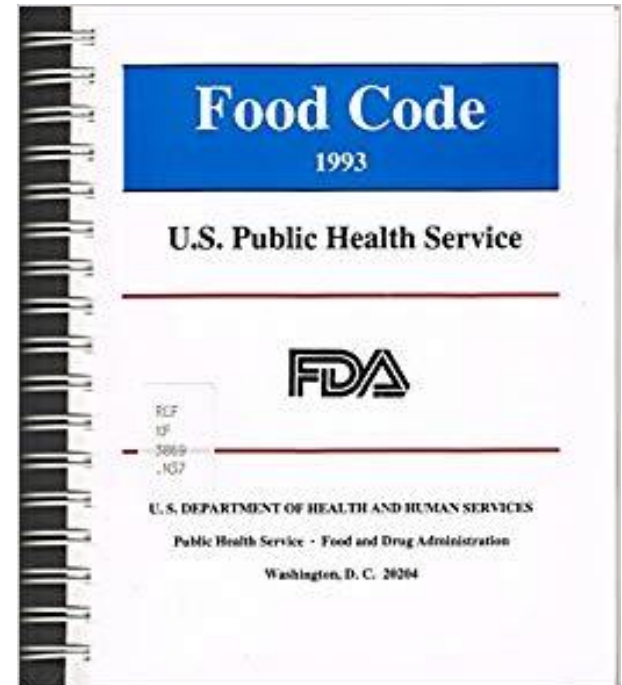
Participating in CFP

- Submit issues to change Food Code
 - Clearly explain the public health need
 - Consult with
 - Stakeholders
 - Peers
 - FDA
 - Develop well before deadline



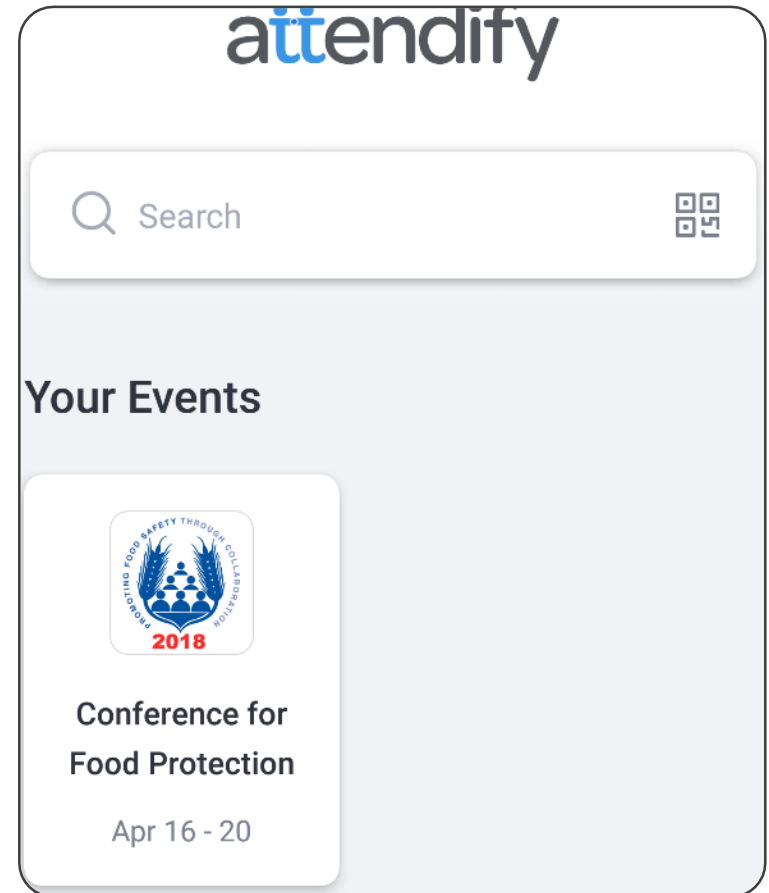
Participating in CFP
